

"The Glorious Church"

Isaiah 60:1-2 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

(2) For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

As we all can see we are clearly in the time of a great darkness upon the earth. Men's hearts are set upon evil continually, and a thick darkness covers their minds. We find this in Paul's writing to the Corinthians:

2 Corinthians 4:3-4 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: (4) In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

So we see through this scripture exactly where the darkness in the earth comes from, which is the god of this world, which is the devil. Now I really want to get into something in this message, I have preached it for years yet people have not yet got a hold of it.

1 John 1:5-7 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. (6) If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: (7) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

God is light, and in Him is NO darkness at all. The darkness we are witnessing today comes from the god of this world. We could say it this way, the devil is in the world to produce darkness through worldliness. Now God's plan to deal with the darkness of this present world, and the darkness that is in men's hearts and minds, is through the church. Jesus said, "...upon this rock I will build my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against

it." (Matthew 16:18) We are called out of darkness and into the marvelous light, (1 Peter 2:9), and to walk in the light as he is in the light, (1 John 1:7), which allows us to have fellowship one with another, bringing us into unity as a body, the church of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Now light has no fellowship with darkness. If we walk in darkness we lie and do not the truth. However if we walk in this light, which is in Christ, we will penetrate the darkness of the present hour, and see the revival we all so desperately long for.

God has a church here in the earth, to reach into the darkness and offer hope and help through the light of Christ. In Him, (Christ), was the life, and the life was the light of men.

Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Christ is the brightness of the Father's glory, and the express image of His person. He is the foundation and life of the church, and when He is lifted up in the earth, he draws all men.

So we as the body of Christ, the church, are called to bring light into the darkened world, and into the hearts and minds of them who are blinded by the god of this world.

Notice the description of the church in Ephesians:

Ephesians 5:25-27 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; (26) That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, (27) That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

He is going to present to himself a glorious church. Now it is really easy to get excited and shout about the glory of God. But notice what it is going to take to make that glorious church...

Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

Sanctifying and cleansing produces a glorious church. As we behold Christ, who is the brightness of the Father's glory and the express image of His person, we are changed into that same image from glory to glory even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

The church cannot and will not shine without being sanctified and cleansed. That is going to take some water! Notice it is the washing of the water by the Word. We need the water of the Spirit of God back in the church.

John 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

That did not say a stream or a trickle, it says RIVERS, plural. Everywhere that there are multiple rivers flowing, they flow with force and power. We need the flowing of God's mighty Spirit to push out the junk and trash that has accumulated in our lives and in the church. We need that well spring of living water. Living water is clean water. It's pure. Without contamination. If we will let the outpour of the Spirit fill the rivers in us, it will get rid of a whole lot of the things that is keeping the church from being a glorious church.

Now it is the washing of the water by the Word. The Word of God produces a cleaning in us that allows us to shine in the darkness.

John 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

When the church strays from the Word it collects dirt. When a Christian puts down their Bible after a while they are going to get a spot, wrinkle, or blemish.

Now this brings us to a very main point in this message. What do we have to be cleaned from?

James 1:27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

Worldliness is the very thing keeping most churches from being full of the glory that will break through the darkness.

Now we find in the book of Titus how we are supposed to live in this world.

Titus 2:11-12 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, (12) Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;

How are we supposed to live? Soberly, righteously, and godly. When? Right now, right here in this present world. And how do we do that? By the grace of God teaching us to deny ungodliness and worldly lusts.

We are to keep ourselves unspotted from the world. So why then is the majority of the so called church world, so consumed with becoming like the world. When you become like something you blend in and lose your influence. Things that are the same are common. This world is in darkness but what is it if the church is allowing itself to become dark, all in the name of making people "comfortable".

I am looking for the glory to return to the church in these last days. I am looking for revival. But we will not have it as long as we refuse to come out from the world and be the city set on a hill we are supposed to be!

God is calling His people to draw nigh to Him in true repentance and humility and be sanctified and washed so the glory will shine as brightness in our lives.

Again, we are in this world but thank God we are not of it.

John 17:15-17 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. (16) They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. (17) Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

1 John 2:15-16 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (16) For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

The glorious church has no place in it for anything that is not of the Father. The glorious church is a church that has not adapted itself to match and blend in with the world, but that has overcome the world!

I tell you in Christ we are more than conquerors. In him we are overcomers.

1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

The anti-Christ spirit is a spirit of worldliness. Christ is the only way and the only answer. A friend of the world is the enemy of God. We better wake up in this nation and realize the power of Christ to overcome the world, not conform to it.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

Jesus has overcome the world. The god of this world holds nothing on him. Now if we are in Him and of the same Spirit as Christ, praise God we can overcome the world as well.

1 John 5:4-5 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. (5) Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

Quit settling for all the things of this world, and rise up, overcome the world and let the glory fill your life. And then when we all come in the unity of the faith as the church, the glory will be so radiant and bright Christ will present himself with His bride.

Isaiah 60:1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

Now the glorious church is going to have to arise. It's been asleep. It doesn't realize the light has come, and the glory of the Lord is risen.

Ephesians 5:14 Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.

Awake! We need to awake. Shake ourselves, and arise. Then Christ will give us the light. Then the light will reprove the darkness. It's not our light it's His light. It's not our ability it's His. It's not our glory it's the glory of God, shining in the face of Jesus Christ.

Colossians 1:27-28 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: (28) Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:

Now God has a way to awaken the church and sanctify and cleanse it. He gave His church some gifts to accomplish this task.

Ephesians 4:11-16 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; (12) For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: (13) Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: (14) That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; (15) But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: (16) From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

God uses ministry to preach, teach, and exhort the Word, that will cleanse the church. Preachers, ministers, we have got a job to do in this hour. And woe to us if we are leading people into worldliness and not into Christ.

The only way to produce this glorious church is to preach Christ. Notice He mentions coming into the unity of THE faith, and of the knowledge of the son of God. What did we just read over in 1st John Chapter 5? The victory that overcomes the world is our faith. The faith of the son of God. Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. (Romans 10:17)

What is it Paul mentioned back in 2 Corinthians, that we need to break the darkness?

2 Corinthians 4:5-6 For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake. (6) For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

We don't preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord. Why? He hath shined in our hearts to give the light...of the knowledge of God...in the face of Jesus Christ. The light of the knowledge of God is what will produce the glorious church. Nothing else. We don't need more programs. We don't need more entertainment. We don't need more of man's

ideas. Folks, we need the light of the knowledge of the glory of God. Quit giving jokes and motivational speeches from the pulpit and get down to business and preach Christ. Get in a prayer closet and seek the face of God until the light shines in your heart, and the glory is revealed unto you, and then stand before God's people and give them that light of the knowledge of the glory of God.

So we see as we conclude this message, there is a plan for God's church to be a glorious church, not having spot nor wrinkle nor any such thing, and that is be holy and without blemish.

Now is the time to do what Romans 12 says.

Romans 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. (2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Let us all, present ourselves unto the Lord, and renew our minds unto the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. Let us deny ungodliness and worldly lusts, and be changed into the image of Christ from glory to glory even as by the Spirit of the Lord. What a glorious life we can have in Christ. A life of liberty and blessings, and a life that will shine into a darkened world and make a difference for the kingdom of God.

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. (16) He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. (17) And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; (18) They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Here we find the commission of Jesus Christ to the disciples, and in fact the church as a whole. We are truly called to be ambassadors of reconciliation proclaiming Christ to a lost hurting world. A world God loved so much He gave His only begotten Son for.

Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

So first we see the command, now in verse 20 we see the obeying of that command and the evidence of what obedience to God's instruction will do. They heard the Lord, and followed the commission preaching Christ EVERYWHERE, and the Lord worked WITH them, confirming the word with signs.

This is the original and true spirit of "outreach".

Those who are born again, delivered by the power of God, and translated from darkness to light have received a GREAT and POWERFUL blessing. With this wonderful blessing however, comes a powerful sense of responsibility.

If we are not the hands, feet, and life of Christ in this world, then how shall men be saved? There must be a preacher, and there must be a passion, and that passion must drive us to REACH OUT!

Romans 10:13-15 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. (14) How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? (15) And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

Outreach is not just a word to throw around to sound good. The word literally means "the ACT of reaching out." We chose to name this ministry "the Voice of Truth Outreach Ministries" because it was the vision to be a "voice of truth", that would "reach out" around the world. God spoke to Rev. A BURDEN FOR THIS GENERATION!

Matthew 9:35-38 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. (36) But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. (37) Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; (38) Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

As we look at all the things that are happening in our world today it is easy to see we are in a very serious and critical condition. We are in a time when evil is called good and good is called evil. A time when standards and values have vanished from peoples hearts and minds, and the wickedness around us is great. A gross darkness is upon the souls of men, blinding them from the love, and victory, that is found in Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

Yet in the midst of all of this, who is really suffering? There are those that are still living that have seen the real move of God's Spirit and power. Their hearts yearn to see it again. Many have known Christ only to fall away into sin and error and false doctrines of men. While these are sad and the church ministers to these groups, there is one group of people whose current condition should bring us to weep with earnest concern and compassion.

This group I am referring to has not seen a real move of God. They are taught that there are many ways to "spirituality", no real right and wrong, and that God is an idea for weak people to cling to, and that He does not really exist. They are taught tolerance for everybody and everything, yet God and Christ is hated among their teachers, and they seek to drive Christianity from all aspects of this nation and its people.

Not having any Godly men and women to mentor them, they are turning to Hollywood, and the pop-culture for their role models. They are looking for answers, looking for the real and the genuine, yet because the church has become people pleasing instead of God fearing, they have turned to all the wrong places for their hope and help, only to find loneliness, emptiness, and severe depression. This group of people is so distressed and hopeless they are committing suicide at alarming rates. In this group **the 3rd leading cause of death is suicide**. This group is suffering and hurting, and confused.

Who am I talking about? Who is this group that I speak of?

The youth. Our precious gifts from God. Our children and grandchildren. Folks we are losing the battle for the souls of this generation. When will we wake up and realize the most important thing the church can do to turn this thing around is invest Christ in the precious lives of our youth.

Jesus looked out over the crowd, the multitudes and he was "moved with compassion on them". Many will not like what I am fixing to say, but I must say it anyway:

For the church to ignore the needs of a generation that is so deprived and destitute of the truth, is downright hypocritical and shameful.

Look around your church next Sunday... If everyone 40 years and up was gone in a week, who would be left? Next, if there are any left under 40, are they getting established in the things of God? Are they on fire for the Lord? Are they being drug to church, or are they willing and excited to be in the house of the Lord?

Please do not misunderstand me. Every church needs all generations. Christ didn't die for just the old, or just the young. He gave His life and shed His blood for all men of all ages. Yet I feel as if the church has committed gross error in 2 things:

First, in many instances we have bought into the lie that the God we believed in and served when we were young, is somehow "not relevant" to a modern generation. We accepted snake oil salesmen that have entered into our churches unawares and told us that "you have got to have something to draw the youth". "You need rock music, entertainment, something catchy and flashy." The church as a whole has tried to re-package and re-invent Christ so many times, there is very little truth left, which is the **ONLY THING THAT WILL MAKE PEOPLE FREE!** Folks, get mad if you want to, but it is no different than the children of Israel coming together to make them their own god out of gold and silver. Elders in the church are living loose and not walking a Godly life, and because of that they have found that "charisma" is much easier than obtaining and maintaining the anointing. Instead of leading the youth into prayer, our youth leaders are leading them to play. Instead of leading youth to a commitment of loving, studying and learning the word of God, we are teaching them how to dance and do "drama". Instead of bringing them to a youth camp where Christ is exalted and preached, and the Holy Ghost can move upon their young hearts, we'd rather take them to a rock concert. We have become more interested in making sure they have "fun", than if their hearts are right with God. **GOD HELP US!**

The second area of error, is on the other end of the spectrum. Knowing the right ways of God, and the truth, yet feeling somehow inadequate. Not only that but allowing the feelings of not understanding the younger generation, hinder us from reaching out to them. Many of the older generation has simply given up on reaching out the youth. They see the rebellion, anger, and hatred that is so prevalent in youth, and allow that to cause the bowels of compassion within them to close up. Rather than being moved with compassion, we allow resentment and fear to cripple our outreach to the youth.

Elders let me say emphatically. **WE NEED YOU!** As Elisha needed an Elijah, as Ruth needed Naomi. As Timothy needed Paul. We need you! You have seen the real power of God. You have walked with God and know the ways of His Spirit. I beg of you, find a young person and pour into them. They need Godly men and women to show them what a true Christian is. Consider what Paul the apostle said concerning this:

Titus 2:2-8 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience. (3) The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; (4) That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, (5) To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed. (6) Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded. (7) In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, (8) Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

Don't gripe at the young, TEACH THEM. They honestly do not know how to live for God. They need a teacher. They need an example. Show genuine compassion, develop a relationship with them, and pour the truth of God's word into their hearts.

I am running out of space for this article so I must come to a close. I did not write this article to lead up to a plug for our youth camp. I did write it because I am very concerned for this generation, and the direction they are being led.

That being said, **I DO wholeheartedly believe that God has called Bible Way Association to reach THIS generation with God's glorious good news, and the power of the Holy Ghost!** Since 1966, Bible Way has held youth camp. Hundreds of young people have had their lives changed by what they received at camp. Many preachers have been raised up out of the youth camp. The point I want to make is this:

Our youth Camp is a way to labor in the white harvest field of this generation. Though this hour is full of darkness, isn't that the time when the light should shine the brightest. **Please let your heart be moved with compassion today, and jump in to help us in this years youth camp. Laborers are needed and I am really praying about this camp.**

I really want to drive a point home here with our Bible Way Churches: Have you promoted and encouraged the Bible Way Youth Camp to your youth? As a Bible Way pastor **YOU** are responsible for seeing that your church participates in Bible Way functions and activities. If you have not yet thought about youth camp, time is running out, please get your youth together and make plans to be here. So far, I have not received ANY Youth Camp applications or staff applications. Remember that if the applications are in by June 1st, it saves the campers \$10 on the registration fee.

Please come let us labor together this year to reach this generation who so desperately need to know the love of God and the peace that passeth all understanding!
