

The Fear Of The Lord

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of two things, they are wisdom and knowledge.

In **Matthew the 10th chapter**, we are talking about fear. There is a perfect love, that is behind the veil. Flesh is not capable of the God kind of love. It is not capable of perfection of this matter other than when it is commanded to come along.

Love is a fruit behind the veil, and there is no fear in the perfect love.

1 John 4:18 *There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.*

So the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom and the beginning of knowledge. So we are back to the soul again, back to **Matthew chapter 10**. Sometimes people are afraid of the wrong

things. We need to fear God and do what? Keep his commandments.

Solomon was a man that really didn't fear God too much or he wouldn't have had seven hundred wives and three hundred concubines and end up in the mess he was in. When God put him in the position that he put him in, he evidently did not have enough fear of God. In the book of **Ecclesiastes**, he told all of his mistakes. Solomon was a good man though, and he took twelve chapters to confess his mistakes. Today, it is usually the other fellow who has made the mistakes instead of us. So we are to fear God and keep His commandments.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 *Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.*

Matthew 10:25 *It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more shall they call them of his household? 26 Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known. 27 What I tell you in darkness, that speak ye in light: and what ye hear in the ear, that preach ye upon the housetops. 28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to*

destroy both soul and body in hell.

Most ministers today have a fear of people. The Bible says to "*beware when men speak good of you,*" because you are in trouble then. If you are going to stir the devil up, you are going to have somebody talking about you all the time, and they are going to be expressing opinions of you. There are a lot of people who do things to get attention. Some of it is because things are not just right, but if you really want to get attention of everybody concerned, just start doing everything the best you can. Get behind the veil, and begin to produce something and you are going to get the attention of everybody that is a believer and the devils' crowd too. They are going to know that you are around and we want the devil to know that we are around.

People can talk about you, but they can not kill your soul, they can not even get to it. They do not know anything about it. They look at you in the fleshly realm because they don't know a thing about spiritual things. You don't fear what people can do.

God is the only one that is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. The soul that sinneth shall surely die. It is the soul that needs to be resurrected. It is the soul that needs saved, and rested and that needs peace, and joy. If that soul does not have any joy, then the flesh does not get anything. It may get something from the wrong

source. The flesh is always seeking to pacify and satisfy, but it needs to get that help from the soul, which got it from the spirit, which got it from God. When it is passed down in that order then it can receive something.

Here is the key to this thing. I hear a lot of preaching on the unity of the faith and unity of the spirit, but do you hear preaching on the unity of the soul? Unity of the soul is in the Bible, unity of the spirit and the soul. Forget about getting the flesh in unity. It will never be in unity with anything until it gets into unity with the soul, which gets handed down from the spirit. You can pound people and browbeat them, but you are just going to make them mad. However, once their soul gets a glimpse of what God is doing, they will begin to want something.

In **Acts 5**, we are going to find some things about unity of the soul and unity of the mind. Have you ever heard somebody say, "If we could just get everybody together." This will tell you how to get them together. Now, if you get a group together and then they do not join in together, they are going to leave because the Bible said, *The sinner can not congregate with the righteous*". It was Lot's righteous soul that was vexed. It is the soul that must become righteous or unrighteous, spiritual or carnal, good or evil. It is the soul that can dictate to the flesh or it can listen to the flesh.

Romans 13:1 *Let every soul be*

subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.

We can preach on the things of this world and it is not going to do much for people, but if we could get them in the unity of the spirit where they can get behind that veil and prosper that soul, the flesh is going to proclaim liberty. Our liberty is to get behind the veil, because we are bound unless we can get behind the veil. Unless you can feast on spiritual things, you are bound. Satan will bind you!

Acts 4:31 *And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. 32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.*

This is the difference between the early church and the church of today. They were not only of one spirit, they were of one soul. The church has the ability to be of one heart and of one soul. The husband and wife are to be one in heart and soul. The church is to be one in heart and spirit and soul because the governor sits upon the throne of our heart behind the veil which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. When the church prayed, they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and when people are full of the Holy

Ghost, their soul and spirit are one. Then, they can prosper. This is what God was talking about when he said, "One will put a thousand to flight and two will put ten thousand to flight."

It is important that we have both spirit and soul in the unity of the faith, even the devils believe and fear and tremble. A lot of people are in unity of A faith, but the unity of THE faith is Christ in you, the hope of glory. This gives us that liberty and we all become as one in the soul and one in spirit.

It is the soul and flesh that causes trouble in the church. One can be a "good person" in heart, then, they get to listening to somebody with their ears and soul. Then the old flesh persuades them and says, "I believe that's right". So the soul disunifies itself from the spiritual realm and it becomes plain that it is a division and a wedge driven in the church which divides. What it is for is the exaltation of the flesh or the carnal mind.

In the early church, they had prayer (their fellowship and contact with God and their unity and ability with God). They were all filled with the Holy Ghost. Everybody got filled with the Holy Ghost and they surrendered their souls. You talk about a church. It's no wonder that they turned the world upside down, because they had unity of the soul. They loved the Lord will all their hearts, their souls, and their minds.

1 Corinthians 1:10 *Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name*

of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

Philippians 2:5 *Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:*

This tells us how we can all have the same mind. The soul, and the mind, and the intellect of man can become Christ-like. How do we get there? Through liberty of seeing from glory to glory.

1 Corinthians 1:9 *God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. 10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.*

What does fellowship mean? It communicates unity or partnership. No wonder he said we were fellow laborers together.

Anybody that breaks that partnership is a rebel. They have rebelled and fought against the things of God. So we are partners together. When one member suffers all have suffered. We all think the same things, and we speak the same thing. What are we supposed to think if we're thinking the same thing?

Philippians 4:7 *And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your*

hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:6 *For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.*

Philippians 2:5 *Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:*

Isaiah 26:3 *Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.*

Our soul and mind is what we think with and you can control your mind. The only way you can do it in the spiritual realm is to get something to feed the mind. If you put a veil over you heart, you can not feel the presence of the Lord and you are not subject to the law of God because your are being carnal minded. You'll never get behind the veil with that attitude. You have to rise up.

Philippians 4:13 *I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.*

Paul said this is when you walk behind the veil and God puts the anointing upon you, when the yoke is destroyed because of the anointing. You have to have the anointing and that's the only way.

Back to **Philippians 4:7**. Christ is in our hearts. We have the liberty to go behind the veil and think on these things.

Hebrews 10:19 *Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,*

God applied the blood to your soul. He consecrated us through the

veil, that is to say, his flesh. So the veil was his flesh and "by his stripes you are healed". By his blood you are saved and by the crown of thorns the curse was done away. His flesh took every bit of that.

Galatians 5:24 *And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.*

The veil was his flesh, then the veil was our flesh in this temple. When we get to that place where we get all the heart, mind and the soul in unity and we love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, the soul, the mind, then, we come into this way of thinking

Back to **Philippians 4:7**. People are not coming to church as much anymore. Church doors are closing because people are not getting down to business with God. They are not loving the Lord their God with all their hearts, with all their souls, and with all their minds. They are not laying aside the weights, as spoken in **Hebrews 12:1**. We need to get on the run. Thinking on these things, will keep our mind and our soul straightened out. Until we get the churches minds, and their souls attention, you will not have revival. They will not have anything because their minds are double minded. And they are thinking all kinds of things.

Romans 13:1 *Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.*

What are we subject to? Are we

subject to God, or are we subject to something else?

Ephesians 3:20 *Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,*

There is power in us. Do you know why the flesh can't go into the realm where the glory is? It would kill it. You have something in there that the flesh can't get to. It has to have it handed down. It has to be like the power that comes off the electric pole. It has to have a transformer, then it will come down into the breakers, and provide the power that produces light and works appliances. Yet, it's the same power. Let every soul be subject to a higher power. We have to go to the source to get the power.

Ephesians 3:20 *Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,*

The source of that power is behind the veil. There you will find the power that's able to do exceedingly above all you ask or think according to that power which is in you. People do not understand how to lay hold onto the power. Some try to hook the flesh into the spirit. But they can forget that. There has to be a transformer in there. Blow the flesh to smithereens, until our mind and our flesh gets spiritualized and goes back and gets what it needs little by little. **Isaiah 28:10** This is the way we got it, here a little and there a little. Sometimes

we have all our wires crossed and blow a fuse a few times, and get shorted out. Where'd it go? The light went out. Where's it at? The light's in our heart.

2 Corinthians 4:6 *For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.*

Romans 13:1 *Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. 2 Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.*

If you resist the power, then you resist the ordinance of God and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. Fear not him that is able to destroy the body, but fear him that is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. They received to themselves damnation.

Romans 13:3 *For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same:*

In other words, you will have praise from the power instead of being afraid of the power, high and lifted up. Humble ourselves under the mighty hand of God and He will exalt us in due season.

Romans 13:4 *For he is the minister of God to thee for good.*

But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil.

The word of God does that as it comes forth, it's either good or it's evil. God's word executes wrath upon evil.

Have you ever heard of someone having a seared conscience? They got a seared conscience when they kept on resisting the power and the things of God. They kept on coming against the minister. The Bible says, "touch not mine anointed". We need to teach people they should never touch that anointing, because it's a very dangerous thing. How do you touch that anointing? When you come into the church and you're not all in one spirit or one heart and one soul, you are touching the anointing a little bit. When everybody comes into the church and their minds are on different things here and there, they are touching the anointing that is in the minister. It's dangerous. The early church understood they needed to be one heart, one soul, and one spirit.

Romans 13:5 *Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. 6 For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing.*






