

Rivers of Life

John 7:38 *He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. 39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)*

We know that it takes a whole lot of little rivers to run together to make a big river. Jesus said in **John 7:38** *He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water (or life). 39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)*

A river has a destination, a Christian that has no destination is not going anywhere. The river's

destination is the sea.

Ecclesiastes 1:7 *All the rivers run into the sea; yet the sea is not full; unto the place from whence the rivers come, thither they return again*

A lot of Christians do not have a destination, or a goal, they do not have anything that they are looking forward to so they do not have anything to shout about. They are like the children of Israel that were in the wilderness, they are just going around and around. Once in a while someone speaks to the rock and some water flows out it, they get a drink and are happy for a while but then it's back in the circle again.

We are talking about rivers with destinations, the Holy Ghost has a destination. The Spirit of God has a purpose, the word of God has a purpose. Jesus was the Word made flesh and dwelt among us, He had a purpose. His purpose was to come and set man free, to die on the cross, to ascend on high, to speak to the Father and the Father sent the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost has come to you and me to produce those rivers that have a purpose, to go into the sea. What is in the sea? In the sea is everything that comes out of every river, all the pollution, all the problems. God wants us to get the rivers of life flowing from us that will go into the sea of troubles. There are people on every

hand that have problems and troubles in this life and the Christians are sitting around without a purpose and without a destination in life, no purpose with the spirit that is within them other than to rejoice a little bit every once in a while. Rivers need to have a destination and that is the sea.

Can you imagine someone that would try to stop a river? That river is going to get to its destination regardless of what we do. Can you imagine someone building a wall to stop a river? You can build a dam across a river, but after a while, that river is going over the dam or around it, because it has a destination. Can you imagine a Christian that can not get over a problem? There is a conflict when you put a dam across a river, the river fills the dam and when it goes over the dam, it produces power. God spoke to Joshua:

Joshua 1:5 *There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee* **6** *Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give them.*

When a Christian has a purpose, nothing stands before them. It may take a little while to get over it, but he goes over after a

while. Many years ago, they built a dam at the Lake of the Ozarks, at that time it was just a river, then it became a lake. It became a source of power and it became a vacation land, a place where there was food in the lake. There are all kinds of things around that lake because the river had a destination. The lake wouldn't be any good if the river didn't go over the dam, it would just be polluted water.

Jeremiah 2:13 *For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.*

We have to have a destination; and every conflict that gets in front of us, we must go over. We must produce the inner spirit of God, and out of that spirit flows that river of living water and when it goes over, it turns into power, it turns into peace and joy, something special. Troubles are good for us because they teach us that we are the producer, through God, of the things that will overcome.

Joshua 1:5 *There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.*

What a promise! As I was with the man who led the children of

Israel out of Egypt, the man who spoke to the rock that produced the water by the rod, I will be with you. Nothing will stand before you all the days of your life, Joshua. No man will stand before you, walls will not stand before you, giants will not stand before you, no obstructions will stand before you, even conflict will not stand before you. You are the conqueror. Paul said in **Romans 8:35** *Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.*

You can not let the water quit flowing, you have to keep the spirit, joy and love moving. Love is something that also flows, joy is something that flows, every one of the nine gifts of the spirit is something that flows. They are another little river that flows.

Think about this: here comes a great big river of life, and that river of life is as clear as a crystal. They tell me River Nile starts out beautiful and clear, they call it the Clear Nile. A little later, as it becomes a little more polluted, so they call it the Blue Nile, then later it becomes more polluted and muddy.

Let's find out the destination of the river.

Ecclesiastes 1:7 *All the rivers*

run into the sea; yet the sea is not full; unto the place from whence the rivers come, thither they return again.

Can you stop a river? If you plug it up in once place, it will find another area to flow out. If we plug up our opportunity and our heart to God, God will use another source. He has a destiny and rivers have a destiny. Where do rivers come from? They come from the sea and it says they go back to the sea. They come from the sea by the sun drawing the pure water out of the sea; the river does not have the salt or the pollutants that the sea has. It just takes the impurities out of there and the rain water and goes back to the mountain and dumps the water on the mountain. The mountain starts letting the rivers flow again and the rivers start flowing down the same course from whence it came and cleanses as it goes, you can not stop it. He said that He would pour out the former rain moderately, but he would pour out the latter rain in abundance.

James 5:7 *Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.*

The latter rain is getting ready to pour and the church had better

get under the spout so that the rivers might flow from us. Rivers have a destiny; nothing can stop them. If we have enough of it, there is something inside of us that we cannot keep the rivers of life from flowing from us. Nothing can stop it; it has a destiny. God does not put anything in us that does not have a destiny. There is someone we can reach for God or prayed for, or someone we can see healed. There is someone we can see saved or see blessed because the river of life flows from us. We are the source; we are part of the sea, we are part of from whence it came. The sea in the Bible always represents the multitudes of people. Why do we have the fire of the Holy Ghost? So it can draw from us to put the latter rain in the sky that the latter rain might get on the inside of us and once again it may flow with a destiny. It is a purification source of God that flows with a destiny. People sit in church and sing about rivers of life and we do not even realize what we are singing about.

Isaiah 32:1 *Behold, a king shall reign in righteousness, and princes shall rule in judgment. 2 And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.*

Jesus is the king that shall

reign in righteousness. A man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land. Why is a man going to be this?

John 3:16 *For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life*

He overcame heaven, he overcame hell, He overcame everything. He sent the Holy Ghost to man that we might produce rivers in a dry place. I am so ashamed of Christians that sit around in church and say, "It is so dry." They are not praying and seeking God, they aren't letting flow, they are holding it back. Everywhere we go, we should flow, we should be a witness.

Matthew 5:16 *Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.*

That is letting it flow, people will know when you have that river inside of you, because there is no stopping it, there is no place you can dam it up. The devil puts obstacles in our way, however, we just let the river go over the obstacle and produce even more power. The river does not stop when it goes over the dam; it goes on to its destiny. You can not stop it because it is living water.

Isaiah 66:12 *For thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will extend peace to her like a river, and the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream: then shall ye suck, ye shall be borne upon her sides, and be dandled upon her knees.*

There is peace like a river, one of the great places I find when I am weary and pressured is the river. I listen to the water go over the rock, it is singing a song, "I am headed for my destiny; I am going to the sea." A bird will fly down once in while and take a dip. When we get ready to baptize someone, we take them down to the river. When we want to go fishing, we go to the river; there are things in there to eat. There are a lot of things in the river, but remember it has a destination, it's going somewhere, it is not just sitting still. That is what will make a Christian strong, if they are always going somewhere. I see people sitting around and the next thing you know they are depressed, distressed and angry, but as soon as they are going somewhere, there is peace, peace like a river.

Psalms 46:1 *God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. 2 Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; 3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled,*

though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah. 4 There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High.

He said there are rivers that roar and rivers that might carry the mountain down to the sea, but there is a river that will make you glad. If you are a believer and full of the spirit of God, according to **John 7:38-39**, there flows not a river, but rivers of living water.

Now let's talk about some of these rivers. A river is something that flows, it is not something that is dead or something that is still. It is not a creek, the difference between a creek and a river is that a creek dries up in the summer-time. It does not say out of your belly will flow creeks. A creek only flows in the springtime when there is an abundance of rain. A cistern never flows, it always has an intake. A lot of Christians are like that; they have a lot of intake but nothing ever comes out, let's think of things that flow. A lot of Christians are not getting anywhere today because they are not letting things flow.

The Bible says in **Matthew 6:33** *But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

Romans 14:17 *For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink;*

but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

If it is peace, righteousness, and joy in the Holy Ghost and I am full of the Holy Ghost, I guess peace, righteousness and joy should flow from me. Love is something that has to flow from us; that is one river. When love quits flowing, one river is gone. Joy flows, you do not get it one service and the next service you are all bound up again, the joy flows. If I were an evangelist and one service I was jumping over the pew and the next service I said I feel bound tonight, you would say that is some evangelist, that is what I think of some Christians. A lot of times things do not suit me, but I still let the joy flow because after awhile it is going to flow over the things that do not suit me. It goes over the obstacles, it goes over the dam, it goes over the conflict. If you have a conflict, let the waters roll and it will go over it after a while. Can you imagine a person holding up something to hold back the river? It would drown the person because it is going over to its destiny.

Love has a destiny, it's destiny is to reach those that are polluted with hate, envy, jealousy, strife, and malice. Only love will cure all of that, only love will wash it way. Joy has a destiny, it has a destiny to go to those people who

have lost their joy. If I release my joy and you release your joy, we are going to wash away the soured up. Bitter and sweet water does not come out of the same fountain. It has to be a river of life.

Psalms 85:6 *Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?*

Revival brings joy. My prayer every day is 'revive me, Lord, that other people may rejoice in you.' If I can not get revived, how are people going to rejoice in the Lord, and I do want people to rejoice.

A river flows like peace, it is going to its destination. It is going to produce peace, love, and joy. It will go over the obstacles and produce power. It will be a peaceful place wherever it flows because it has peace, love and joy.

Long-suffering, sometimes we will build some big obstacle and the river will back up and it takes a long time but it will go over. The river is long-suffering because it takes all the junk to the sea. When it gets to the sea, there is a fire. The Bible says He will baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire. The fire will draw the pure water out of the sea, carry it back to the mountain and we will have the latter rain. What is in the sea? Salt water, salt purifies and you are the salt of the earth, you are the beginning of the river. You produce the latter rain.

Jesus said:

cause they are rivers that go into the rivers of life. The rivers of life carry it to the destination which is the sea. All the rivers finally get to the sea.

Where is your river, is it a river that is gentle and ever flowing with life. We need to be the witness that God wants us to be and let that river of life flow from us to help others in their time of trouble and despair. God will help you, if you let him.

Urgent Help Needed for our Camp Grounds!

Just before the June Camp Meeting last year one of the old 10 ton air conditioning units that cooled the Tabernacle finally quit on us. It has been necessary over the years to make repairs on this unit nearly every year just to make it through the meetings. We have had to spend thousands of dollars over the years just to keep them working enough to get through the meetings. The units were well used when they were installed in 1997, but have served the purpose and have kept the Tabernacle comfortable most of the time.

We have recognized the need to replace these units, however, the Association has never been able to have enough funds on hand to make the purchase. Last year was different, however, and extraordinary because during our time of need several people recognized what needed to happen and responded to make it possible.

One Brother who was participating in the Camp Meeting was aware of our need and was able to get great prices on two new high efficiency units.

Brother Buckner prayerfully felt led to make the need known during one of the services. During just that one service God spoke to the hearts of those who were there and nearly the total amount was given, in offerings and pledges, some of which were very sacrificial to provide for the purchase of these units. What a time of rejoicing and giving God the glory. When we looked at the records later the funds for the purchase was accomplished by just 16 individuals or churches. Praise the Lord for those who hear what God is saying and will be obedient doers of His will! Almost \$10,500 was raised that evening. We had much to give thanks to God for since most of the expense for the entire Camp was also given during the other services. This was in the hearts of those people at that time. Praise God!!!

NEXT STEP.....

We immediately ordered the two new 7 ton heating and air units and after a few delays we now have those two new units delivered and ready for installation.

Even though the new units are smaller by capacity their configuration will require a major upgrade to our electrical service. The electric company will require a much larger service entrance before we can install them. This problem has become a sizable mountain that we are working to overcome. As of this date we have not been able to afford the installation costs. We have evaluated every possible savings and are reusing everything possible.

OUR NEEDS....

The electric cooperative has put us under a great hardship currently requir-

ing the upgrade of our 3 phase service to equal an 800 amp entry service with the necessary disconnects and fusible ratings to handle the current services plus the new air conditioners. They will only permit one electrical entrance into the building because of safety and their policies regarding liability. This means we must purchase all new boxes and fusible disconnects to protect the new units and to distribute the services to the existing fuse boxes.

In summary, the new entrance service could cost as much as \$7500 for disconnect and distribution boxes plus another \$4000 for the entrance cables. Labor for this installation could be another \$500.

The new entrance could therefore cost us about \$12000.00

The installation for the new air conditioners will total approximately another \$7200. This will include the new concrete pads, the wiring for the new units, the additional ductwork that will be required and the necessary repairs to the building that this would create.

We can do most of the labor, with the help of anyone who wished to participate and see this come to pass before the September Camp Meeting.

Without these new Air Conditioners we are forced to rely on the only remaining unit which is at the end of its life cycle as well, and will pray that it doesn't fail us. We would then be forced to move the Camp Meeting somewhere else since the heat is just too great during the June camps to have indoor meetings without A/C.

IN CONCLUSION!

The current total estimated cost is just over **\$19200.00.**

Please be assured that we are committed to doing anything and everything possible to limit these costs, however, even with those efforts we need your help! By ourselves this seems insurmountable, but as a group effort, and working together with Godly prayer and His provisions, this can become a reality to the glory of God!

I realize this is a great deal of money, but God is bigger than our need. **Remember God moved on only 16 people and churches to purchase the new A/C units costing over \$10,500. Is anything too hard for the Lord!**
